Aggravated Robbery – Metro PCS 1101 N. Jupiter Road Richardson, Texas

On Friday, June 27, 2014, at approximately 3:26pm, Richardson Police responded to a disturbance call involving the report of shots being fired at the Metro PCS business located at 1101 N. Jupiter Road. Responding officers soon learned that a robbery had just taken place. A description of the suspect vehicle was broadcast over the police radio and the vehicle was spotted by RPD officers. The suspects inside the vehicle refused to stop and instead began to flee. They abandoned their vehicle in the area of Clear Springs Drive and E. Lookout Drive fleeing on foot into a nearby Garland apartment complex. One suspect was quickly taken into custody. The second suspect managed to get to a family member's apartment in the complex where he barricaded himself. RPD Negotiators and SWAT team members were called in to secure the area and to negotiate surrender by the suspect. After approximately 2 ½ hours the suspect surrendered himself without incident.

No one was injured by the gunfire at the scene of the robbery or the activity at the apartment complex.

Both suspects have been charged with aggravated robbery and felony evading. Their names and photos are being withheld pending further investigation into possible involvement in other crimes.

The Richardson Police Department was assisted by the Garland Police Department and a DPS Helicopter Unit during the incident.
