

Richardson Police Department News Release

Robbery 540 E. Buckingham Road, Richardson, TX

On September 16, 2009, at approximately 9:47 a.m., Richardson Police responded to a home invasion style robbery in the 500 block of E. Buckingham road. Initial investigation indicated that as the female victim went outside her apartment, at approximately 2:30 a.m., that morning she was approached by three black males. They produced pistols and escorted her back to her apartment where they robbed her and her husband of their personal property and miscellaneous electronic items from inside the apartment. Two of the suspects took the male victim to several ATM machines for cash and to several stores where they used the victim's credit card to purchase computer related items. One of the suspects remained with the female victim and held her at gunpoint while the other two left with the male victim. They returned to the victims' apartment and released them at approximately 9:30 a.m.

At 4:30 p.m. that afternoon, Richardson Police arrested 22-year-old Dallas resident, Paul Glen Willis III and charged him with two counts of aggravated robbery and engaging in organized criminal activity. Police are still seeking a 15-year-old juvenile and 20-year-old O'Bryan Aljuwon Gilyard, a.k.a. "O.B." of Dallas. Both are believed to be together in the Oak Cliff area.

If you know the location of Mr. Gilyard or have any information that may assist investigators, you are asked to contact the Richardson Police at 972-744-4801. Mr. Gilyard and the juvenile are considered armed and dangerous.
