Bank Robbery – Bank of Texas 1600 E. Belt Line Road, Richardson, TX

On Saturday, November 21, 2009, at approximately 12:45 p.m., Richardson Police responded to a robbery at the Bank of Texas located at 1600 E. Belt Line Road in Richardson. The suspect entered the bank and demanded money from a teller. The suspect gave the teller the impression that he had a gun by having his hands in his jacket pockets and pointing something through the pocket towards her while making his demand. The suspect fled from the bank on foot and was last seen in the local neighborhood. No getaway vehicle was observed.

The suspect is described as either a black or Hispanic male approximately 6'-00'' tall, 230 pounds, in his mid 20's. He was last seen wearing a white sweatshirt with a hood under a blue jacket, black mask, dark gloves, black watch cap and sunglasses. He was carrying a black canvas messenger / computer style bag.
