Bank Robbery / Bank of America 111 N. Plano Rd. Richardson, TX

On January 21, 2009 at approximately 5:29 p.m., a subject robbed the Bank of America located inside the Albertson's Grocery store at 111 N. Plano Road, Richardson, Texas. The suspect passed a demand note to the teller and left with an undisclosed amount of money. No weapon was displayed and no one was hurt during the robbery.

The suspect is described as a black male, in his late 20's to early 30's, approximately 5'-09" tall, 180 pounds, slim build with no observed visible tattoos. He was wearing a white Texas A & M baseball cap, a dark colored jacket and dark pants.
