Aggravated Assault 3500 Blk. Park Vista Road, Richardson, TX

On June 2, 2012 at approximately 9:30 A.M., Richardson Police responded to an aggravated assault in the 3500 block of Park Vista Road near Breckinridge Park.

The initial investigation determined that the female victim was travelling on Park Vista Road in her motor vehicle when she was waved down by what appeared to be a white male jogger. He was requesting the victim's assistance with his injured dog in a wooded ditch line. When she exited her vehicle to assist him, he grabbed a hold of her, pushed her down and attempted to get her into the wooded area just off of the roadway. The suspect brandished a utility / box cutter knife during his attack. The victim fought off her attacker and used a self defense can of pepper spray to ward off his attack. The suspect was last seen running from the area. The victim received minor injuries.

The suspect is described as a white male, 20 -30 years-of-age, short dark hair, blue eyes, clean shaven and approximately 6 foot tall with a slim build. He was last seen wearing beige running shorts and a beige t-shirt.

If someone was in the park area and observed anyone matching the above description or may have observed an individual getting into a vehicle displaying signs of exposure to pepper spray such as; exertion, difficulty breathing, coughing or watery eyes they are asked to contact the Richardson Police at 972-744-4801.
