



GREENVILLE AVENUE “ROAD REVEAL” COMMUNITY EVENT

OCT. 17, 4-6:30 P.M.

**DART ARAPAHO CENTER STATION
1051 N. GREENVILLE AVE.**

A “Road Reveal” event at the DART Arapaho Center Station will take place Oct. 17 from 4-6:30 p.m. to get input from transit/bicycle riders, area businesses, workers and residents on the temporary improvements that have been made in the area.

Temporary on-street bike lanes have been installed on Greenville Avenue from Campbell Road to Jackson Street and a temporary at-grade crosswalk has been installed at the light rail station as a secondary point of access. The duration of the temporary demonstration is approximately 60 days. Following this, City Council will evaluate the project’s effectiveness and any potential permanent improvements. If proven successful, the lanes and crossing will be made permanent by July 2020. The project was funded through a grant provided by the AARP Community Challenge Program, and the “Made To Move” grant provided by Degree® Deodorant and Blue Zones® will fund the permanent installation next year.
