## 8 Yard Residential Container Leasing

Residents wishing to lease a container for disposal of materials around their homes must call the Solid Waste Division at (972) 744-4111 to make a reservation. All fees will be charged to the resident's utility bill which include: \$60 per haul fee, landfill fees, and taxes.

The City will deliver the container to the resident's home and drop it into the driveway (**the container cannot be set on the street or in the alley**). A maximum of two weeks will be allowed to keep the container on your property. If the City of Richardson does not receive the notice for cancellation of service prior to the two weeks, the City will automatically schedule the pickup of the container.

### Restrictions:

- Due to the North Texas Municipal Water District (NTMWD) owning and operating the transfer stations, the City must abide by their rules and regulations. Therefore, the following material is prohibited in the container: E-Waste, C&D - Renovation/Demolition debris to include but not limited to: Shingles/Roofing Material, Cabinets, Wood, Tile, or Laminate Flooring, Sheetrock/Paneling, Lumber, Glass/Mirror, Windows, Doors - including Storm Doors and Shower Doors, Asphalt, Bricks, Concrete, Rocks, Gravel, Dirt, Sand, Sod, etc., Compressed Gas/Air Cylinders, Vehicle Parts - including tires and any material not originating from resident's own property. At the owners' expense, you may acquire a Richardson Permitted C&D hauler or take your prohibited material to the NTMWD landfill in Melissa, Texas.
- The container shall not contain any material that is hazardous (**toxic, corrosive, reactive, ignitable, radioactive, paint, oil, etc.**) or liquids.
- The container shall not be overloaded (**lids must be able to fully close on the container**). The Solid Waste Division reserves the right to ask the resident/business/contractor to take debris out of the container if, in the City's opinion, the container is overloaded or contains prohibited materials.
- The material loaded into the container shall not exceed the length, height, or width of the container.
- Any loose material, such as rubble, rubbish, leaves, paper, or grass clippings, must be contained in tied bags or boxes.
- The person leasing the container will be responsible for any breakage or damage to the container or vehicle.

## 20-30 Yard Open Top Container Rental

Residents/Businesses wishing to lease an open top container for disposal of materials around their homes/business must call the Solid Waste Division at (972) 744-4111 to make a reservation. All fees will be charged to their utility bill.

The 20-yard open top or the 30-yard open tops carry a rental charge. The rental fee for the 20-yard is \$164 for every 30-day period or \$5.47/day. The rental fee for the 30-yard open top is \$171 for every 30-day period or \$5.70/day. The fees are in addition to any haul charges, landfill fees, and taxes and are based on the initial set date only. Having the container emptied will not reset the monthly rental charge date. A one-time \$75 set fee will apply to the 20-yard and 30-yard open top containers. (Rates subject to change, call (972) 744-4111 to confirm pricing.)

The City will deliver the container to the resident's home and back it into the driveway (the container cannot be set on the street or in the alley) or in the desired location of the business's property. At the appointed time, the City will pick up the container and haul it to the transfer station. The 20-yard container is \$319 per haul and the 30-yard container is \$352 per haul plus applicable landfill fees and taxes.

### Restrictions:

- Due to the North Texas Municipal Water District (NTMWD) owning and operating the transfer stations, the City must abide by their rules and regulations. Therefore, the following material is prohibited in the container: E-Waste, C&D - Renovation/Demolition debris to include but not limited to: Shingles/Roofing Material, Cabinets, Wood, Tile, or Laminate Flooring, Sheetrock/Paneling, Lumber, Glass/Mirror, Windows, Doors - including Storm Doors and Shower Doors, Asphalt, Bricks, Concrete, Rocks, Gravel, Dirt, Sand, Sod, etc., Compressed Gas/Air Cylinders, Vehicle Parts - including tires and any material not originating from resident's own property. At the owners' expense, you may acquire a Richardson Permitted C&D hauler or take your prohibited material to the NTMWD landfill in Melissa, Texas.
- The container shall not contain any material that is hazardous (**toxic, corrosive, reactive, ignitable, radioactive, paint, oil, etc.**) or liquids.
- The container shall not be overloaded (**lids must be able to fully close on the container**). The Solid Waste Division reserves the right to ask the resident/business/contractor to take debris out of the container if, in the City's opinion, the container is overloaded or contains prohibited materials.
- The material loaded into the container shall not exceed the length, height, or width of the container.
- Any loose material, such as rubble, rubbish, leaves, paper, or grass clippings, must be contained in tied bags or boxes.
- The person leasing the container will be responsible for any breakage or damage to the container or vehicle.
