CHAPTER 13: MISCELLANEOUS OFFENSES AND PROVISIONS ARTICLE VI. PLANTS AND STRUCTURES ALONG STREETS, ALLEYS, ETC.

Sec. 13-141. - Overhang of trees restricted; plantings in alleys.

- (a) The minimum overhang of trees and vegetation shall be seven feet above sidewalks, and 14 feet above the street or alley surface.
- (b) Paved alleys All trees and vegetation must be trimmed one foot back from the alley pavement.
- (c) Unpaved alleys All trees and vegetation shall not exceed one-foot encroachment from the property line into the alley easement or utility easement.
